Aim and focus of the event

The Women's Major Group (+350 organisations, 80 countries) will present key recommendations from its position paper on SDGs and post-2015. It is essential that the analysis and recommendations from the perspective of civil-society women's and gender organisations is taken into account. The authors of the position paper are women's and gender representatives from the Global South who have taken the lead in developing their views and priorities, and which form the basis for the consultation and input from all members of the women's major group, with support from GIZ and UNWOMEN.

The event will build on the first discussion with members of the Network of Women Ministers and Leaders for the Environment, during the Gender Forum at UNEP on 17 of February.

Format of the event

The event will be in the format of a dialogue, where representatives of the Women's Major Group and of UNWOMEN will briefly introduce their proposals on concrete targets and indicators for SDGS, followed by a discussion with member state and civil society representatives.
